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Dear Parents and Carers,

We are just sending out a few reminders for Year 3 to ensure there is no confusion regarding homework and late arrival and to tell you about a visit we will be having in the coming weeks!

Homework

Children are expected to read every night for 10 minutes and this needs to be recorded each time in their white reading record. These reading records need to be signed by an adult at home at the end of each week. These then need to be brought into school every FRIDAY to be checked by their teacher. If children have read and recorded the correct number of times, they will receive a Marvellous Me house point.

Homework projects need to be handed in on the allocated dates. If children have completed the homework and handed it in on time, they will receive a homework project badge on Marvellous Me worth 5 house points. The Autumn 1 project is due Thursday October 11th.

Maths homework is handed out each Monday and needs to be handed Thursday of the same week. The homework is based on learning the children have been doing in class the previous week. Guidance on presentation and expectations are stuck in at the front of the book. Any questions should be referred to the class teacher BEFORE Thursday. This is marked with the children on Thursday. If it is handed in late, it will not be marked. If it is handed in on time and completed, children will receive 1 Marvellous Me house point.

Arriving Late

If children arrive after the bell, children must be brought to the reception area. Children and parents are not allowed to enter the classroom through the cloakroom doors where the children leave at the end of the day. This is for the safety of the children. We appreciate your support with this.

Year 3 Visit

Tuesday afternoon, 23rd October, the children will be receiving a visit from Surfers Against Sewage. They will be doing an assembly to inform the children about plastic pollution in the ocean. This is to educate the children as part of our Ocean Topic about the impact it is having and what we can do to improve the situation!
