

# Year 5 homework – Spring 2

## Topic – Frozen Planet

All children are expected to complete Novice. You may then progress through to Apprentice, Practitioner and Expert.

**Novice** – Research what Global Warming is, what is causing it and what effect it is having on our planet.

**Apprentice** – Continue your research to find out how we can stop Global Warming. What do we need to do as a whole world? What can we do individually?

**Practitioner** – Use what you have learnt through your research to create an informative, persuasive leaflet/poster to tell people; What Global Warming is, what is causing it, what effect it is having and what we must do to help stop it.

**Expert** – Write a story from the viewpoint of an animal in a Polar region, that is being effected by global warming. What is happening to habitat? What do they see? What do they experience? How do they feel about it? Use the descriptive techniques we have been using in lessons.
